The news has raised concerns about the safety of school buildings; Stephen Munday, who is the CEO of the CAM-Academy Trust, shared the following with us: 'One immediate piece of reassurance given the scale of the news item on school buildings and some very serious issues for some schools. We are told that none of the schools in the Trust, following the appropriate surveys, has so called RAAC, the type of concrete that is apparently crumbling in some school buildings.

Next week, we are having **Meet the Teacher** events for parents. Please see the dates below. This is an opportunity for you to say hello to your child's class teacher and to see the classroom where they are spending their days this year! It might only take a few minutes, so parents with more than one child, should be free to meet more than one teacher. Children will be free to leave with parents afterwards – but please do inform the class teacher. Please can I remind parents that while in the school building, they should **not** be using **mobile phones**. This is part of our safeguarding procedures. We understand that some parents may be working or have other arrangements and will not be able to visit, please let your child know that you won't be there, to avoid disappointment. If you would find it helpful, speak to the class teacher about another time which is convenient for both of you when you could meet.

We have a school council which will be meeting for the first time soon. In our school council, we will be discussing **playground games**! Why don't you tell your child about some games that you played when you were at school.
