


Soft	Marks made by pressing lightly
	with a drawing tool.
Broad	A line that is thick.
Observation	Looking carefully at a shape or
	object and drawing from what we
	can see .
Fine	A very thin or narrow mark.
Pattern	A repetitive mark of that can be
	repeated or alternated.
Line	A mark made by a tool or
	instrument as it is drawn across
	a surface.
Shape	An area that stands out from
	the space next to or around it
	because of a defined edge or
	change in colour or texture.
Detail	Looking closely at each detail of
	an object.
Post-	Post-Impressionism is a mostly
impressionism	French art movement that
	developed roughly between 1886
	and 1905.
