<p><u>EYFS and Year 1/2:</u> Reading - children having limited access to books of their level has had an impact on children's fluency</p>	<p>Purchase of new phonic books and ensure additional reading time is within every KS1 classroom</p>	<p>£1,700 – half paid for by The Friends of Gamlingay VP</p> <p>EEF – support great teaching</p>	
<p><u>KS2</u> Home Learning – ensuring that all children have equal access to SATs prep learning / resources</p>	<p>Purchase a home learning guide, that every child will have. This will stay at home, to stop items coming to and from school but will be directed for home learning each week</p> <p>Some small group tuition</p> <p>Booster Groups and Whole School Leadership (Assessment / Groups / Interventions etc)</p>	<p>CPG books - £365 in total</p> <p>Small Group tuition - £1000</p> <p>M1 Teacher 0.6 – £14 000</p> <p>EEF – support great teaching and improving pupil assessment and feedback</p>	
<p><u>Whole School:</u> Gaps in learning -Groups of children who have gaps in their learning due to not always completing the daily learning sent home</p>	<p>Small group interventions</p>	<p>£6,000</p> <p>Afternoon TA to ensure that each KS has an afternoon TA to carryout year group specific interventions, these include FC@N, BRP and SAA, as well as reactive, feedback intervention</p> <p>Delivering one to one and small group tuition</p>
