Key Vocabulary

Audience - People giving attention to something.

<u>**Collaboratively</u>** - Something that is produced by, or involves, two or more parties working together.</u>

<u>Concept</u> – An idea.

<u>Concept Map</u> - A tool for organising and representing knowledge. They form a web of ideas which are all interconnected.

<u>Connection</u> - A relationship or link between two nodes or ideas.

Idea - An opinion or belief

Node – A way to represent concepts or ideas.

<u>**Thought</u>** - An idea or opinion produced by thinking or occurring suddenly in the mind.</u>

<u>Visual</u> - A picture, piece of film or display used to illustrate or accompany something.



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
