The LGB membership shall comprise:

- Two members ex-officio: the CEO of the Trust and the Head(s) of School/Principal;
- Two elected members of staff, each to serve for four years (so long as they remained members of staff) from the date of their election;
- Two elected parents, each to serve for four years (or for so long as they remained eligible as parents with children in the school) from the date of election;
- Not fewer than eight, nor more than twelve Trustee Governors, appointed by the Trust. These governors are to serve for four years on a four-year rolling cycle, from the beginning of the academic year. Any casual vacancy is to be filled, in the first instance, for the remainder of the term of office of the departed governor.
