- Judaism and Christianity share their belief in the creation story as it comes from the Old Testament.



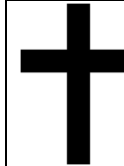
Key vocabulary

Preservation	To guard and protect something.
Humanity	Human beings as a group.
Creator	A name given to God. Someone that brings something into existence.
Responsibility	Having a duty to deal with something or of having control over someone.
Response	An answer to something.
Brahma	The first god in the Hindu Trimurti.

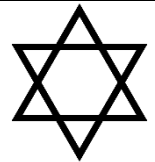
Key Knowledge

Christians, Jews, Muslims and Sikh's all believe in a God as creator.

Belief can create a sense of responsibility and a response.



Jews and Christians believe in God as the Creator and the world as God's gift to humanity.



- Brahma created the heavens, earth and sky using a lotus flower.
- He then created animals, plants and trees and gave the animals the senses of touch, sound, movement and sight.
