Key Knowledge

- Epiphany means 'to show' 'to make known' to reveal'. Jesus was revealed as Lord and King, but as a human being on earth.
- Epiphany is the festival when Christians remember the visit of the Wise Men to Baby Jesus in Bethlehem
- John the Baptist prepared people for Jesus' birth this is remembered and celebrated today through the Christian Christmas preparations known as Advent.
- Christians believe and use the prophecies given in the Bible as a guide for their lives.
- Christians all believe that the Christmas story is significant. However, some Christians view the story in a metaphorical way while others believe the story is literally true.
